**A RESOLUTION DECLARING CERTAIN STERILIZING EQUIPMENT OF THE
CENTRAL PENINSULA GENERAL HOSPITAL AS SURPLUS EQUIPMENT AND
AUTHORIZING ITS DISPOSAL BY TRADE-IN ON NEW STERILIZING
EQUIPMENT**

WHEREAS, the Central Peninsula General Hospital is purchasing state of the art 3M gas sterilizing equipment for the safety of patients and staff; and

WHEREAS, for safety reasons, it is in the best interest not to relocate or dispose of locally the Sterivac model 400B and Aireator model 33A sterilizing equipment currently in use; and

WHEREAS, the trade-in value of the Sterivac model 400B and Aireator model 33A is reasonable as deemed by the Central Peninsula General Hospital Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Sterivac model 400B and Aireator model 33A sterilizing equipment at the Central Peninsula General Hospital is declared to be surplus equipment.


SECTION 2. That the Central Peninsula General Hospital is authorized to trade in this equipment on a new 3M gas sterilizer.

SECTION 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
