RESOLUTION 93-18**

**A RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING A LIST OF PROJECTS FOR FEDERAL  
FISCAL YEAR 1994 FOR THE BOROUGH-WIDE ROADS AND TRAILS PLANNING  
PROGRAM TO BE INCLUDED IN THE AK DOT&PF'S SIX YEAR CAPITAL  
IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM**

**WHEREAS,** the Kenai Peninsula Borough created a Borough-wide Roads and Trails Planning Program and initiated efforts through both a Transportation Policy Committee and Technical Committee with Resolution 93-11; and

**WHEREAS,** the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities is continuing with the establishment of a Local Roads Improvement Program which will use federal funds under the Intermodal Surface Transportation and Efficiency Act of 1991 (ISTEA); and

**WHEREAS,** the Borough Assembly is requested to recommend and approve project priorities for ISTEA funding under the State Local Road Improvement Program; and

**WHEREAS,** the borough has agreed on the coordination of developing the regional planning process involving both areas within the cities and all areas within the borough; and

**WHEREAS,** the Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities has requested that the borough assist in completing a list of projects that would be designated for Federal Fiscal Year 1994 in the category of both road construction and enhancement projects construction; and

**WHEREAS,** the ISTEA Act requires that a minimum of 10 percent (10%) of the borough's allocation be dedicated to enhancement type projects; and

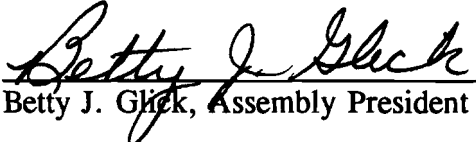
**WHEREAS,** the ISTEA Transportation Policy Committee and Technical Committee have reviewed and produced a list of projects that are available to be recommended for inclusion in the Federal Fiscal Year 1994 funding list;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI  
PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

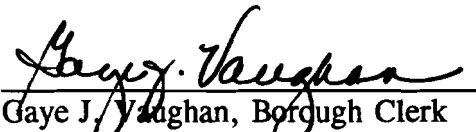
**SECTION 1.** That the revised list (dated 2/16/93 V.1) as enclosed with this document is recommended for submittal to the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities. This revised list of projects is to be listed under Federal Fiscal Year 1994 in the AK DOT&PF Six (6) Year Capital Improvement Plan. The Plan is to be submitted by AK DOT&PF to the Federal Highway Administration under the Borough Transportation Plan for the Kenai Peninsula Borough. These project lists and cost estimates can be amended by the borough at a later date.

**SECTION 2.** That this resolution shall take effect on February 17, 1993.
