- WHEREAS, the Department of Community and Regional Affairs, on an annual basis, awards grant monies to eligible coastal districts for their required program activities; and
- WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough adopted its Coastal Management Program in 1992; and
- WHEREAS, the number of Coastal Zone Management consistency reviews conducted by Kenai Peninsula Borough increased annually; and
- WHEREAS, Kenai Peninsula Borough reviews more applications for permits under the Coastal Zone Management program than any other coastal district; and
- WHEREAS, the recent announcements of new and expanded oil and gas activities in Cook Inlet are cause to project a higher level of Coastal Zone Management program activities thereby requiring additional resources; and
- WHEREAS, the application to DCRA for FY 1993-94 funding is due for submittal prior to April 9, 1993;

- SECTION 1. That the Assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough supports the application to the Alaska Department of Community and Regional Affairs for funding the Borough's FY 1993-94 Coastal Zone Management Program
- **SECTION 2.** That the assembly recommends full funding of the application request for the amount of \$110,339.00.
- **SECTION 3.** That copies of this resolution shall accompany the application and be sent to the Commissioner of DCRA.
