**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THE REMOVAL OF ONE UNDERGROUND STORAGE TANK AT THE MOOSE PASS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, TRANSPORTING EXCAVATED SOIL TO AN ADEC PERMITTED SOIL PROCESSING FACILITY, AND TANK EXCAVATION SITE RESTORATION**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough Finance Director solicited and received bids for the labor and equipment required to perform the work; and

**WHEREAS**, two bids were received and the low successful qualifying bidder was Jackson Construction with a bid of Eight Thousand Six Hundred Ninety Nine Dollars (\$8,699.00);

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**


**SECTION 1.** The Mayor is authorized to award a contract in the amount of \$8,699 to Jackson Construction for removal of one underground tank at the Moose Pass Elementary School, for transportation of excavated soil to an ADEC permitted soil processing facility, and for tank excavation site restoration.

**SECTION 2.** That funds are available for this project in Account No. 265-325060-49999-910002.


**SECTION 3.** That the Mayor is authorized to execute all documents and make all agreements deemed necessary to carry out this resolution.
