**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 93-40**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING SB 183 AND HB 269 WHICH PROVIDES FOR A
NUMBER OF RESTORATION PROJECTS RELATING TO THE EXXON VALDEZ
OIL SPILL WHICH ARE BENEFICIAL TO THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH**

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska has received \$50,000,000 as remedial and compensatory payments to be used exclusively for restoration projects relating to the Exxon Valdez oil spill; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the Exxon Valdez oil spill the Kenai Peninsula Borough is in need of restoration, replacement, and enhancement of affected resources; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the Exxon Valdez oil spill the Kenai Peninsula Borough is in need of long-term environmental monitoring and research programs directed to the prevention, containment, cleanup, and amelioration of oil spills;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly supports SB 183 and HB 269 which provides for a number of restoration projects relating to the Exxon Valdez oil spill which are beneficial to the Kenai Peninsula Borough.
