**A RESOLUTION ACKNOWLEDGING THE CONTRIBUTION WOMEN MAKE TO
THE WELL-BEING OF THE COMMUNITIES OF THE KENAI PENINSULA, THE
ECONOMIC GROWTH OF OUR PENINSULA, AND TO THE INFRASTRUCTURE
SO VITAL TO THE GROWTH OF THIS BOROUGH**

WHEREAS, working women now account for 47% of the labor force and will account for nearly 50% of all workers by the year 2000; and

WHEREAS, working women have been and are an integral and permanent part of our community's history; and

WHEREAS, the increasing number of women in the work force requires ongoing effort by leaders of government, business and labor to develop long-range solutions to address child and dependent care needs, employment and wage discrimination, training and retraining needs, social security and pension inequities and others; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough of the State of Alaska recognizes the important contributions working women make to their work places and communities; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to increase public awareness of their contributions and the concerns they face; and


WHEREAS, nation-wide May 2 - 8 is celebrated as "Working Women's Awareness Week";

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:


SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly does recognize the many contributions working women make to our communities and economy.
