RESOLUTION 93-47

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THE PROJECT THAT INCLUDES FIELD SCREENING, AND SAMPLING AND ANALYSIS OF PETROLEUM CONTAMINATED SOIL STOCKPILES CURRENTLY STORED AT THE SOLDOTNA AND HOMER SOLID WASTE FACILITIES TO CHARACTERIZE SOILS FOR PREPARATION OF SOIL REMEDIATION BID DOCUMENTS

WHEREAS, the Borough Finance Director solicited and received proposals for the labor and equipment required to perform the work; and

WHEREAS, two proposals were received and the proposal submitted by RZA AGRA Alaska Inc. received the highest score;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to award a contract in the amount of Eleven Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$11,750) to RZA AGRA Alaska Inc. for performing field screening, and sampling and analysis of petroleum contaminated soil stockpiles currently stored at the Soldotna and Homer solid waste facilities to characterize soils for preparation of soil remediation bid documents.

SECTION 2. That funds are available for this project in Account No. 265-325060-49999-91001.

SECTION 3. That the Mayor is authorized to execute all documents and make all agreements deemed necessary to carry out this resolution.

SECTION 4. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
