RESOLUTION 93-53**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE ADMINISTRATION
TO WORK TOWARD THE COMPLETION OF
THE LAND USE SECTION OF THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN**

WHEREAS, the section of the code, commonly referred to as Section 21.12, was deleted from the Kenai Peninsula Borough Code of Ordinances; and

WHEREAS, this Section 21.12 had been used in a quasi-zoning manner; and

WHEREAS, with its deletion from the KPC it is in the best interest of the citizens of the Kenai Peninsula Borough to have some guidelines in place that can be used for the optimum usage of individuals' property with the least impact on surrounding neighbors; and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly requests the Administration to complete the Land Use Section of the Comprehensive Plan utilizing the GIS maps that show the current utilization of the land.


SECTION 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly requests the Administration hold community meetings to solicit input in regard to classification and land utilization within the district and that those comments where applicable be included in the land use section of the comprehensive plan.

SECTION 3. That this resolution takes effect upon its adoption.
