**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 93-62**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING ASSEMBLY TRAVEL TO JAPAN

WHEREAS, an Agreement on the matter of exchanges between the Kenai Peninsula Borough (Alaska U.S.A.) and the City of Akita (Akita, Japan) was signed on January 22, 1992; and

WHEREAS, in order to establish lasting and friendly ties, communications have been exchanged on a regular basis; and

WHEREAS, to further the exchanges, members of the Akita Prefecture and businessmen visited the Kenai Peninsula in July and October of 1992; and

WHEREAS, the Kanto Festival (Lantern Festival) is a yearly event, occurring this year in August; and

WHEREAS, to continue the exchange of information and to continue cementing ties between Akita and the Kenai Peninsula Borough, a delegation representing the Borough will be attending the Kanto Festival.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That _____ is authorized to represent the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly at this event.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
