**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 93-72**

**A RESOLUTION CLASSIFYING BOROUGH LANDS AS RURAL
PURSUANT TO KPB 17.10.080**

WHEREAS, the Borough has received patent from the State of Alaska for those lands under the Municipal Entitlement Act; and

WHEREAS, KPB 17.10.080 establishes a process for Borough lands to be classified; and

WHEREAS, an application for classification was received on March 12, 1993; and

WHEREAS, these lands have been identified as traditional lands by the Point Possession Native Corporation; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with KPB 17.10.080 public notice has been published and posted, notification has been sent to land owners and/or lease holders of record within one-half mile of the areas to be classified, to applicable agencies, and interested parties, and public meetings were held in Seward and Soldotna; and

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission held a public hearing on the classification at its meeting of June 14, 1993 and recommended that the lands included in the legal description in Section 1 be classified as rural.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That those Borough owned lands within the following legal description are lands classified as Rural:

S $\frac{1}{2}$, S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, T11N, R7W, S.M., Alaska containing 440 acres and Section 30, T11N, R6W, S.M., Alaska containing 640 acres

SECTION 2: That this classification shall take effect immediately upon adoption of this resolution.
