KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 93-78

A RESOLUTION PROPOSING THE ACQUISITION OF HEALTH CARE POWERS TO
INCLUDE THE PROVISION OF HEALTH CARE INSURANCE PROGRAMS
FOR RESIDENTS OF THE BOROUGH AND
SETTING A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSAL

WHEREAS, the cost and limited availability of health care insurance has reached alarming proportions; and

WHEREAS, it may be beneficial to the borough populace for the borough to acquire the powers necessary to provide or arrange for health care insurance and basic health care services; and

WHEREAS, a combination of providing basic services and insurance may best meet the needs of the residents rather than limiting authority to health insurance alone;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That the assembly proposes the Kenai Peninsula Borough acquire areawide municipal power to provide for health care services and programs which would specifically include the authority to establish and operate or arrange for health care insurance plans for residents of the borough.

SECTION 2. That in accordance with the requirements of Alaska statute for proposed acquisition of power, a public hearing on this subject will be scheduled during the next regular assembly meeting of August 3, 1993. This hearing will be in conjunction with a resolution to place a proposition for acquiring this power on the ballot for the October 5, 1993 municipal election.


SECTION 3. That the assembly president may schedule additional public hearings upon this subject at locations within the borough prior to the public hearing scheduled for August 3, 1993.

SECTION 4. This resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
