**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 93-79**

**A RESOLUTION CLASSIFYING BOROUGH LANDS AS RESOURCE EXTRACTION
PURSUANT TO KPB 17.10.080**

WHEREAS, KPB has received a final decision granting management authority from the State of Alaska for the lands described below under the Municipal Entitlement Act; and

WHEREAS, initial investigation has established that these lands contain commercial quantities of borrow materials (sand, gravel and rock); and

WHEREAS, KPB has been working cooperatively with the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities in the development of a mining plan to provide for extraction of borrow materials necessary for the Homer East End Road improvement project, which is scheduled to begin in July of 1993; and

WHEREAS, KPB 17.10.210 requires Borough lands that are to be utilized for commercial sand, gravel, and material disposal to first be classified as Resource Extraction; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with KPB 17.10.080 public notice has been published, notification has been sent to land owners and/or leaseholders of record within one-half mile of the areas to be classified, and to applicable agencies and interested parties.

WHEREAS, the Kenai Peninsula Borough Planning Commission held a public hearing on the classification at its regular meeting of July 12, 1993 and recommended that these lands included in the legal description in Section 1. be classified as Resource Extraction;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That those Borough managed lands within the following description are lands classified as Resource Extraction:

E½ Section 9, Section 16, Section 17, N½ Section
18, Township 4 South, Range 11 West, Seward
Meridian, Alaska containing ±1,920 acres

SECTION 2. That this classification shall take effect immediately upon adoption of this resolution.
