**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 93-80**

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO NEGOTIATE AND
EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF ALASKA TO PROVIDE
BOROUGH BORROW RESOURCES TO THE STATE IN EXCHANGE FOR
THE CONSTRUCTION OF A HAUL ROAD AND DEVELOPMENT OF
THE BORROW PIT**

WHEREAS, the Borough has selected and received patent to former State lands in the Homer East End Road area upon which borrow (gravel) resources have been discovered; and

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska Department of Transportation and Public Facilities has informed the Borough that its planned East End Road improvement project will necessarily be scaled back or dropped unless a local (east of Homer) source of borrow materials is developed; and


WHEREAS, the State has agreed to enter a contract through which the State would open and develop borrow resources located on Borough lands in section 9, T4S R11W, Seward Meridian and construct a haul road between the pit and the State road system in exchange for the right to utilize all borrow materials necessary for that development and for the State's proposed improvement project for Homer East End Road;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Mayor is authorized to negotiate and execute such documents and agreements as necessary to provide for State development of borrow resources within section 9, T4S R11W, Seward Meridian, and construction of a haul road to that development in exchange for State use of that borrow material for the Homer East End Road Project.

SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
