RESOLUTION 93-81

**A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A ROYALTY POLICY FOR EXTRACTION OF  
SAND AND GRAVEL ON BOROUGH SITES**

**WHEREAS**, the Borough owns lands that contain deposits of sand and gravel that have been or can be developed for extraction of these resources; and

**WHEREAS**, KP.B 17.10.200 and .210 contemplate sale of sand and gravel in accordance with market conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, no fee or royalty has been established for payment to the Borough for extraction of these resources upon sale or use;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Assembly adopts a policy that sand and gravel from Borough owned sites shall be subject to a royalty to be paid to the Borough for the materials extracted and removed from the site. The royalty shall be a base of one dollar and fifty cents per yard (\$1.50/yard) with the Mayor having authority to establish amounts that vary from this base by up to one dollar per yard (\$1.00/yard) higher or lower, depending upon the market conditions prevalent in various areas of the borough at the time an arrangement for extraction is made.


**SECTION 2.** That all royalty payments shall be deposited in the land fund.

**SECTION 3.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
