**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A SISTER CITY RELATIONSHIP
WITH AKITA, JAPAN**

WHEREAS, the City of Akita, Japan, and the Kenai Peninsula Borough have mutual interests in educational, economic and cultural exchanges; and

WHEREAS, educational exchanges of both students and teachers will benefit the young citizens of our two areas and lay a solid foundation for the future of our relationship; and

WHEREAS, many areas of economic interest, including sandfish and tourism, exist; and

WHEREAS, cultural exchanges will further the understanding and cooperation of our two areas' citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:

SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly endorses the concept of a sister city relationship with the City of Akita, Japan.


SECTION 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly extends its warmest greetings in friendship to the citizens of Akita.

SECTION 3. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly trusts that this is the beginning of a long, fruitful and many faceted relationship.
