**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING ADOT TO UNDERTAKE A COMPLETE
ENGINEERING AND SAFETY ASSESSMENT OF THE ISLAND LAKE ROAD AND
NORTH SPUR HIGHWAY INTERSECTION IN NIKISKI**

WHEREAS, two serious accidents occurred at the intersection of Island Lake Road and North Spur Highway in Nikiski within a two-day period; and

WHEREAS, this intersection has historically been the scene of numerous serious traffic accidents, several fatal; and

WHEREAS, new safety implements would reduce the possibility of further catastrophic incidents; now, therefore,


BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:

SECTION 1. That the Alaska Department of Transportation is requested to undertake a thorough assessment of the Island Lake Road and North Spur Highway intersection.

SECTION 2. That DOT is requested to implement all procedures, devices and upgrades at this intersection at the earliest date to address the safety deficiencies inherent to this intersection.

SECTION 3. That copies of this resolution be sent to Governor Walter J. Hickle, DOT Commissioner Bruce Campbell, Representatives Mike Navarre, Gail Phillips, Gary Davis and Senators Judy Salo and Suzanne Little.
