**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A TAPE DRIVE SYSTEM  
FOR THE BOROUGH'S MAINFRAME COMPUTER**

**WHEREAS**, funds to purchase a new tape drive system for the A-6NSU mainframe computer through the equipment replacement fund were appropriated in the FY93-94 budget; and

**WHEREAS**, proposals were solicited resulting in four responding vendors; and


**WHEREAS**, the review committee independently and unanimously selected the system proposed by The Virtual Group;

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

**SECTION 1.** That the mayor is authorized to purchase a DAT tape drive system from The Virtual Group of Rochester Hills, Michigan for \$31,532 through the equipment replacement fund.

**SECTION 2.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
