**A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING OCTOBER AS
NATIONAL BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH**

WHEREAS, October has been proclaimed as National Breast Cancer Awareness Month; and

WHEREAS, the National Breast Cancer Coalition estimates there are 2.6 million women with breast cancer, one million of whom have yet to be diagnosed; and

WHEREAS, 182,000 women will be diagnosed in 1993 alone; and


WHEREAS, 46,000 women will die of breast cancer this year;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly joins the nation in recognizing October as National Breast Cancer Awareness Month.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
