**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE DNR
ADVISORY PANEL ON THE STATE'S 5-YEAR TIMBER HARVEST PLAN**

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska, Division of Forestry has prepared a plan to harvest this timber on their land over a 5-year period; and

WHEREAS, the Commissioner of the Department of Natural Resources appointed an advisory panel to review this 5-year timber harvest schedule; and

WHEREAS, the advisory panel held meeting in Soldotna, Homer, Ninilchik and Moose Pass to solicit public input and to personally tour some of the proposed timber harvest areas; and

WHEREAS, based on these meetings and tours has submitted a report to the Commissioner on the proposed 5-year timber harvest plan (complete copy attached); and


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly supports the concept of a 5-year timber harvest plan as one of the tools to be used in the managing a healthy forest.


SECTION 2. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly endorses the recommendations of the advisory panel and urges the incorporation of these recommendations in all 5-year timber harvest plans.
