KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH RESOLUTION 93-130

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO AWARD A CONTRACT FOR THE USED OIL COLLECTION PROGRAM

- WHEREAS, the Borough Finance Director has solicited and received proposals for the Used Oil Collection Program; and
- WHEREAS, two (2) proposals were received, evaluated and scored and the proposal submitted by Alaska Pollution Control received the highest score; and
- WHEREAS, Alumi-Ferrous was rated at three points less than Alaska Pollution Control, however, the proposal costs were approximately equal; and
- WHEREAS, borough purchasing and procurement allows for preference to local bidders who maintain and operate businesses within the boundaries of the borough when bids are approximately equal;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 1. The Mayor is authorized to provide local preference to award a contract to Alumi-Ferrous in the amount of Ten Thousand Two Hundred Dollars (\$10,200) for pumping, transporting and recycling used oil collected at the Central Peninsula and Homer Baling Facilities, Seward Transfer Facility and the Kenai Transfer Site. The term of the contract is for one year beginning January 1, 1994 and ending December 31, 1994 with a renewable option for two additional one year terms.
- **SECTION 2.** That funds are available in account number 100.320010.43011.
- **SECTION 3.** That the Mayor is authorized to execute all documents and make all agreements deemed necessary to complete this project in accordance with the Resolution and contract documents.
- **SECTION 4.** That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
