**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE NIKISKI PARENT/TEACHER
ASSOCIATION'S REQUEST FOR ADEQUATE TROOPER COVERAGE IN THE
NIKISKI AREA**

WHEREAS, one of the goals of the Nikiski Elementary PTA is to promote safety among parents, staff and students; and

WHEREAS, there has been identified in the Nikiski area a disproportionate degree of vandalism and other dangerous criminal activity, particularly in the schools; and

WHEREAS, the population of Nikiski and the immediate surrounding area constitutes more than 10% of the total Kenai Peninsula Borough population and is without consistent, adequate police protection; and

WHEREAS, one of the duties of state government is to provide its residents living outside municipalities with adequate police protection; and


WHEREAS, the location and accessibility of Nikiski make it particularly vulnerable to victimization by criminal elements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly strongly urges the State of Alaska to provide consistent, adequate Trooper coverage in the Nikiski area, and to immediately take steps necessary to station a Trooper or Troopers full time in Nikiski.

SECTION 2. That copies of this resolution be sent to Governor Walter Hickel, Richard L. Burton, Commission of Public Safety, Senators Suzanne Little and Judy Salo, and Representatives Mike Navarre, Gary Davis and Gail Phillips.
