**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 93-12**

**A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A REQUEST FOR CAPITAL FUNDING THROUGH
THE VILLAGE SAFE WATER PROGRAM FOR A WATER SYSTEM IN THE
VILLAGE OF NIKOLAEVSK, ALASKA**

WHEREAS, the Nikolaevsk Village Community Council, Inc., represents the unincorporated community of Nikolaevsk, located within the boundaries of the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to provide adequate sanitation facilities for the residents of Nikolaevsk, Alaska, and has determined the community water system to be the number one priority for the community; and

WHEREAS, the new system is needed to comply with Alaska Department of Environmental Conservation and U.S. Environmental Protection Agency water treatment regulations; for sanitation improvements to correct health and pollution hazards; and for fire protection for the community; and

WHEREAS, the Council has submitted an application to DEC Village Safe Water Program for Phase I funding in the amount of \$342,000 for design and water source development necessary to improve Nikolaevsk's water system problems; and

WHEREAS, the annual costs for operations and maintenance of the system will be funded through user fees to the homeowners and the school district;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly hereby supports Nikolaevsk's request for funding through the Village Safe Water Program for design and development of a community water system.

SECTION 2. That this project be included in the KPB's 1993 Legislative Priority List under unincorporated communities, as Nikolaevsk's number one priority.

SECTION 3. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
