A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING AN INDUSTRY DEVELOPMENT FORUM

WHEREAS, a forum shall be created to discuss the concerns of various industries and the public in dealing with competing interests arising from future oil and gas development in the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, this forum is a result of the Out Look Forum '93 and public hearings regarding Lease Sale #78; and

WHEREAS, numerous industries that operate within the Kenai Peninsula Borough have expressed an interest in such a forum;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:


SECTION 1. That the Mayor, in cooperation with the Assembly President and the Cook Inlet Regional Citizens Advisory Council, plan an Industry Development Forum to be held no later than December 1, 1994.

SECTION 2. That representatives from the oil industry, commercial fishing organizations, sport fishing industry, forestry industry, tourism industry, state and federal agencies, and citizens be invited to participate in this forum.
