**A RESOLUTION DECLARING PRINTING EQUIPMENT AS SURPLUS AND  
AUTHORIZING DISPOSAL BY SEALED BID**

**WHEREAS**, the following printing equipment is no longer utilized since the shutdown of the Borough's full-size print shop:

Multigraphics electrostatic plate maker  
Multigraphics tandem press  
Multigraphics System 7 transport to towers with five collating towers  
Pitney Bowes 10-bin collator  
Pitney Bowes 50-bin collator  
Xerox 920 jogger/stapler  
Challenge paper drill  
Bostitch wire stitcher  
Wrapid Seal II sealing system

**WHEREAS**, the School District was offered and accepted printing equipment from the print shop that was of use to them; and

**WHEREAS**, the best method of disposal of the remaining equipment would be through a sale by sealed bid to the highest bidder for each individual item;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**


**SECTION 1.** That the printing equipment no longer utilized by the Borough is declared as surplus and is to be sold individually by sealed bid to the highest bidder.
