**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 94-063**

**A RESOLUTION PLACING THE QUESTION OF THE EXPANSION OF POWERS
FOR THE SOUTH PENINSULA HOSPITAL SERVICE AREA BEFORE THE VOTERS
OF THE SERVICE AREA AT THE REGULAR BOROUGH ELECTION ON
OCTOBER 4, 1994**

WHEREAS, South Peninsula Hospital is currently limited to the legal authority to provide for hospitals within the service area; and

WHEREAS, the Service Area Board has considered the changes in medical care delivery in recent years, and determined that a more effective delivery could be achieved with a broader range of powers; and

WHEREAS, the Service Area Board has requested that the assembly submit to the voters a proposition for expansion of the powers of the Service Area; and

WHEREAS, any expansion of the legal authority would be subject to the enactment of an appropriate ordinance within that authority by the assembly of the Kenai Peninsula Borough; and

WHEREAS, the assembly determines it to be in the best interest of the public to consider expansion of the powers to broader general health care as proposed by the Service Area Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That the following proposition shall be placed on the ballot for the voters of the South Peninsula Hospital Service Area at the October 4, 1994, regular borough election:

PROPOSITION:

Shall the South Peninsula Hospital Service Area, in addition to the authority to provide for hospital services, be authorized, subject to Assembly approval, to provide home and community-based health care services, wellness programs, long-term care services, and personal care attendant services within the Service Area?


SECTION 2. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
