**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE METHOD OF SALE OF GLASS
SALVAGED DURING THE RENOVATION OF THE NIKISKI POOL**

WHEREAS, glass was salvaged through donated labor during the demolition phase of the Nikiski Pool renovation project; and

WHEREAS, the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area Board has declared this salvaged glass as surplus; and

WHEREAS, the North Peninsula Recreation Service Area Board has requested that this surplus glass be sold to the general public by the pane with a six pane per sale limit and at a price per pane to be determined by an estimate from local glass vendors ;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:


SECTION 1. That Kenai Peninsula Borough Code, Section 5.28.500 B. authorizing the sale of surplus tangible property by sealed bid or at public auction is waived.

SECTION 2. That Kenai Peninsula Borough Code, Section 5.28.500 D. requiring notification to Borough agencies of surplus property availability is waived.


SECTION 3. That the Finance Director is authorized to offer the salvaged glass from the demolition of the Nikiski Pool for sale to the general public by the pane with a six pane limit per sale and at a price per pane to be determined by an estimated value from local glass vendors.

SECTION 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
