A RESOLUTION AWARDING A CONTRACT FOR RADIO BROADCASTING BOROUGH ASSEMBLY MEETINGS

- WHEREAS, the Radio Broadcast Sub-Committee of the Policy and Procedures Committee has met with representatives of broadcast stations located on the Kenai Peninsula; and
- WHEREAS, an agreement has tentatively been reached with Peninsula Communications, Inc. [PCI] which owns and operates KPEN-FM, which broadcasts and translates in Homer, Seward, Kenai, Soldotna, Nikiski, Ninilchik, Sterling and Tyonek areas, to broadcast the Assembly meetings in the central, eastern and southern areas of the borough;
- WHEREAS, this proposal will save the Kenai Peninsula Borough several thousand dollars from the amount presently budgeted for this project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the assembly hereby authorizes and approves a contract substantially similar to the contract attached to this Resolution and incorporated herein by reference.
- **SECTION 2**. This contract is the result of direct negotiations with interested broadcasters, and any deviations from the terms of the Kenai Peninsula Borough Purchasing Code are hereby approved.
- SECTION 3. That this resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
