**A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING OCTOBER AS  
NATIONAL BREAST CANCER AWARENESS MONTH**

**WHEREAS,** an estimated 46,000 women will die from breast cancer in 1994, making it the second major cause of cancer deaths among women, after lung cancer; and

**WHEREAS,** each year a woman is exposed to more "background" radiation in her daily life than she receives from an annual mammogram; and

**WHEREAS,** early diagnosis for breast cancer through mammography may save lives; and

**WHEREAS,** October is recognized as Breast Cancer Awareness Month and October 19th as National Mammography Day; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**

**SECTION 1.** That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly joins the nation in recognizing the month of October as National Breast Cancer Awareness Month and encourages peninsula women to follow recommended breast screening guidelines.

**SECTION 2.** That this Resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
