**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE RESIGNATION OF
ASSEMBLYMAN JOHN TORGERSON AND
DECLARING A VACANCY ON THE ASSEMBLY**

WHEREAS, John Torgerson was initially elected to serve as an assembly member from Assembly District 2, Seat D, on October 1, 1991; and

WHEREAS, following Assembly reapportionment, John was elected to serve as the assembly member from Assembly District 7, Tustumena, on October 6, 1992; and

WHEREAS, on November 8, 1994, John was elected to serve in the Alaska State Senate; and

WHEREAS, John has submitted his resignation from the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly effective January 16, 1995, thus creating a vacancy for District 7;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH ASSEMBLY:

SECTION 1. That the Assembly extends congratulations and best wishes to John in this new endeavor.


SECTION 2. That the resignation of John Torgerson is hereby accepted.

SECTION 3. That the Borough Clerk is directed to advertise the vacancy created in Assembly District 7 and forward copies of all declarations of candidacy received to the Assembly President and members of the Assembly on January 3, 1995.
