**KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH
RESOLUTION 2006-099**

**A RESOLUTION TRANSFERRING FUNDS BETWEEN ACCOUNTS
TO PAY FOR THE COST OF AREA-WIDE BOARD MEMBER TRAINING**

WHEREAS, the administration has identified a need to provide training to those borough residents who serve on the borough boards and commissions, including service area board members, commission members, and others who serve in an oversight capacity; and

WHEREAS, the training would include guidance on their roles and responsibilities, conflict of interest, open meeting requirements, legal liability, relationship of the boards with borough staff, parliamentary procedures, and budgets; and

WHEREAS, the administration has estimated the cost of providing this training to cost approximately \$12,000; and

WHEREAS, funds have been identified within the non-departmental budget transfer to debt service, that could be transferred to non-departmental contract services to cover this costs; and

WHEREAS, KPB 5.04.100 allows the assembly, by resolution, to transfer unencumbered balances between major classifications or departments;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That \$12,000 is transferred from non-departmental transfer to debt service, account number 100.94910.00000.50308 to non-departmental contract services, account number 100.94910.00000.43011, to cover the cost of providing this training.

SECTION 2. That the mayor is authorized to enter a contract in the amount of \$9,750 with ClerkWorks Alaska to provide this service.


SECTION 3. That this resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption.

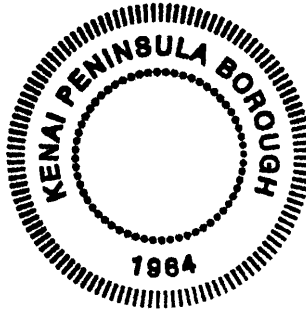
