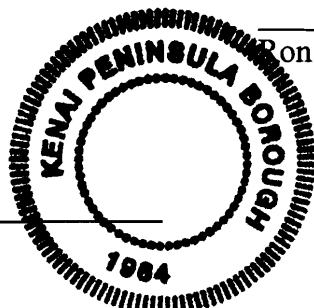
SECTION 2. That a copy of this resolution and accompanying priority list shall be provided to Governor Palin and all legislators representing the Kenai Peninsula Borough.


SECTION 3. That this resolution becomes effective immediately upon its adoption.
