SUBJECT: Resolution 2006-103, Kachemak Emergency Service Area agreement

This resolution authorizes the mayor, on behalf of the Kachemak Emergency Service Area, to continue to operate for an additional three months under the existing agreement with the City of Homer for provision of fire and emergency medical services. The present agreement expires December 31, 2006, and the parties are in the process of negotiating a new agreement. However, it is believed that an additional three months will be needed to reach a new agreement.

The resolution also provides that the new agreement will be retroactive to January 1, 2007, unless the parties agree otherwise. This is so that the new agreement will continue to follow the budget cycle of the City of Homer, which is run on a calendar year basis.
