
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- SECTION 4.** That in Assembly District 8, G. William “Bill” Smith was elected to a 1-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.
- SECTION 5.** That in School Board District 1, Lorraine “Sammy” Crawford was re-elected to a 3-year term, having received the greatest number of votes cast.

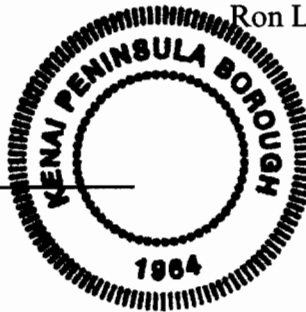
