A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING GOVERNOR PARNELL'S FY2013 BUDGET REQUEST OF \$1,813,000 FOR A KENAI RIVER KING SALMON ASSESSMENT **PROGRAM**

- WHEREAS, Kenai Peninsula sport, guided sport and commercial fishers are dependent on strong Kenai River king salmon stocks; and
- WHEREAS, management of Kenai River king salmon stocks is provided by the Alaska Department of Fish and Game (ADF&G); and
- WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Fish and Game has spent more than 25 years and millions of dollars attempting to count Kenai River king salmon using sonar, and has failed to yet establish a reliable system; and
- WHEREAS, the Alaska Department of Fish and Game has a plan for implementing changes to the site location and devices used to count Kenai River king salmon; and
- WHEREAS, said plan is estimated to cost \$1,813,000 for a multi-year study beginning in FY2013; and
- WHEREAS, Governor Parnell has recognized the need for best management of Kenai River king stocks and has included the necessary funding in his FY2013 capital budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the KPB Assembly respectfully requests the Alaska State Legislature to approve funding for the Kenai River king salmon sonar assessment program as submitted by Governor Parnell.
- **SECTION 2.** That the KPB Assembly respectfully requests the Alaska Department of Fish and Game to seek an independent review of their king salmon assessment program prior to implementation.
- SECTION 3. That this resolution shall be sent to Alaska Department of Fish and Game Commissioner Cora Campbell and all members of the Alaska Legislature.

SECTION 4. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
