SOUTH PENINSULA HOSPITAL BOARD RESOLUTION 2012-04

A RESOLUTION OF THE SOUTH PENINSULA HOSPITAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS APPROVING A LEASE UPGRADE FOR OUR CURRENT PYXIS PHARMACY SYSTEM

WHEREAS, the number one reason to obtain Pyxis equipment is for patient safety as Pyxis will separate lookalike and sound-alike drugs; and

WHEREAS, Pyxis produces inventory savings with less shrinkage and lost charges since it monitors inventory much more closely than a manual system and would result in an estimated savings of 5-10% of the monthly drug-spend; and

WHEREAS, currently the Pyxis computerized pharmacy system is in the ER, Acute Care and Pharmacy and the hospital currently uses a manual system in the operating room, obstetrics department and long term care. The computerized system and manual system create inefficiencies and workflow challenges to the department as they are used together; and

WHEREAS, standardizing the I/T systems, technology, information and workflow across the hospital will leverage efficiencies, improve patient safety and drive best practices; and

WHEREAS, \$255,235 capital outlay is not allowed in this year's Capital Budget; and

WHEREAS, \$4,180 would be the monthly cash outlay for leasing the Pyxis system which includes the equipment and maintenance fees for new equipment; and

WHEREAS, leasing allows product returns and replacement with another product of equal value providing consistency and standardization; and

WHEREAS, Pyxis allows for integration of data between medical devices and HIT systems supporting the flow of critical information to provide clinical alerts, cost management, case charging and regulatory compliance across all CareFusion products (Pyxis); and

WHEREAS, nursing time is decreased for controlled-substance inventory reconciliation at the end of the shift; and

WHEREAS, this resolution was approved by the Finance Committee at its February 15, 2012 meeting.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF SOUTH PENINSULA HOSPITAL, INC. TO

- 1. APPROVE A LEASE UPGRADE FOR OUR CURRENT PYXIS PHARMACY SYSTEM AS OUTLINED; AND
- 2. FORWARD THIS RESOLUTION TO THE SOUTH KENAI PENINSULA SERVICE AREA BOARD AND KPB ADMINISTRATOR FOR APPROVAL.
