- WHEREAS, America's 49th state is now home to one of 49 National Heritage Areas; and
- WHEREAS, the Kenai Mountains-Turnagain Arm National Heritage Area was established in 2009 to recognize, preserve, and interpret historic scenic, recreational resources and cultural landscapes of the Kenai-Turnagain Arm area; and
- WHEREAS, the Kenai Mountains-Turnagain Arm National Heritage Area encompasses a region that includes the Eastern District of the Kenai Peninsula Borough, running north-south from Bird/Indian to Seward; and
