A RESOLUTION APPROVING A FIVE-YEAR OPERATING LEASE OF A SYSMEX HEMATOLOGY ANALYZER FOR SOUTH PENINSULA HOSPITAL

- WHEREAS, the South Peninsula Hospital's (SPH or hospital) current hematology analyzer is over seven years old and is in need of replacement; and
- WHEREAS, South Peninsula Hospital, Inc. (SPHI) evaluated three brands of analyzers and Sysmex stood out as the analyzer most capable of meeting the hospital's needs; and
- WHEREAS, SPHI is proposing to enter into a five-year operating lease with Sysmex for a new hematology analyzer, with monthly payments of approximately \$2,409 which are included in the hospital's operating budget for FY2013; and
- WHEREAS, section 13(e) of the sublease and operating agreement requires that SPHI receive authorization from the borough assembly prior to entering into any lease in excess of \$100,000; and
- WHEREAS, the SPHI board of directors at its June 27, 2012, meeting approved a lease agreement for a Sysmex hematology analyzer; and
- WHEREAS, the South Kenai Peninsula Hospital Service Area board at its July 12, 2012, meeting recommended approval of the hematology analyzer lease agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That South Peninsula Hospital, Inc. is authorized to enter into a five-year operating lease for a Sysmex hematology analyzer with monthly payments of approximately \$2,409.
- **SECTION 2.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
