- **WHEREAS**, pursuant to AS 26.23.140 this declaration continues for a period of seven days unless extended by the assembly; and
- WHEREAS, the assembly wishes to extend this declaration as the flooding still continues requiring ongoing emergency response activities;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

- **SECTION 1.** That the declaration of local disaster emergency previously issued by the borough mayor on September 21, 2012 is hereby extended for a period of 60 days in order to allow for appropriate response by the borough. A copy of the local disaster emergency declaration extended by this resolution is attached and incorporated herein by reference.
- **SECTION 2.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
