**AN EMERGENCY RESOLUTION EXTENDING THE DECLARATION OF LOCAL
DISASTER EMERGENCY FOR FLOODING IN THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH**

WHEREAS, the borough mayor issued a local disaster emergency declaration on September 21, 2012, due to flooding throughout the Kenai Peninsula Borough including the cities of Kenai, Soldotna, Homer, Seward, and Kachemak City, and areas surrounding each city, the communities of Tyonek, Beluga, Nikiski, Salamatoff, Sterling, Cooper Landing, Bear Creek, Kasilof, Ninilchik, Nanwalek, Anchor Point, and other areas determined to have been damaged by major rainstorms and flooding; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to AS 26.23.140 this declaration continues for a period of seven days unless extended by the assembly; and

WHEREAS, the assembly wishes to extend this declaration as the flooding still continues requiring ongoing emergency response activities;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI
PENINSULA BOROUGH:**



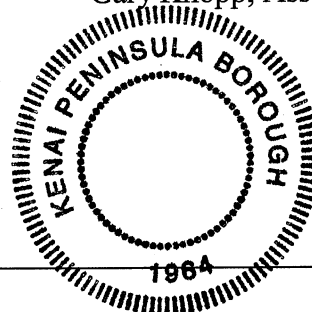
SECTION 2. That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
