A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM PROVIDED BY THE STATE OF ALASKA DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE, COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT DIVISION OF COMMUNITY AND REGIONAL AFFAIRS FOR A PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY PROJECT

- WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant Program (CDBG) is a flexible source of competitive funding for a broad range of community development projects that benefit low and moderate income residents; and
- WHEREAS, the residents of Kachemak Selo, Fox River Census District Precinct, have expressed the need for a public school facility to house kindergarten through twelfth grade students; and
- **WHEREAS**, elementary and secondary education is currently taught in three houses that have been converted to classrooms; and

- WHEREAS, the school district will provide the cash contribution required to meet the 25 percent match; and
- WHEREAS, it is in the borough's best interest to apply for the CDBG funds for the purpose of this project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the mayor is authorized to negotiate, execute and submit any and all documents required for participation in the CDBG program including granting and managing funds awarded by the Alaska Department of Commerce,

Community and Economic Development under the CDBG program for a public school facility project in Kachemak Selo, Fox River Census District Precinct.
