COMMENDING RESOLUTION**

**A RESOLUTION COMMENDING CAPTAIN HUBERT “GLEN” GLENZER
FOR HIS WORK WITH OIL SPILL PREVENTION AND RESPONSE
ON THE COOK INLET REGIONAL CITIZENS ADVISORY COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, Captain Hubert “Glen” Glenzer has served on the Board of Directors of the Cook Inlet Regional Citizens Advisory Council (CIRCAC) since its inception in 1990; and

WHEREAS, Captain Glenzer has been a willing and effective ambassador for CIRCAC and has tirelessly carried the message that prevention needs to be the primary focus of oil spill planning; and

WHEREAS, as a veteran of the US Navy, a past official with the Alaska Department of Transportation and a past Director of the Port of Anchorage, Captain Glenzer has been an effective link between the Citizens of Anchorage and the shipping industry that conducts business in Cook Inlet; and

WHEREAS, Captain Glenzer oversaw the development of CIRCAC’s Long Range Plan and was a key proponent in CIRCAC’s Safety of Navigation in Cook Inlet Forum and has supported development of Geographic Response Strategies for Cook Inlet; and

WHEREAS, Captain Glenzer, president of the Board of Directors of CIRCAC, was one of nine Legacy 2000 Award winners named by the States-British Columbia Oil Spill Task Force at its annual meeting in Monterey, California on July 25, 2000;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:

SECTION 1. That the Kenai Peninsula Borough Assembly commends Captain Hubert “Glen” Glenzer as a recipient of the States-British Columbia Oil Spill Task Force Legacy 2000 Award.

SECTION 2. That a copy of this resolution shall be given to Captain Glenzer.
