**A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE
SUMMER GUARDIANS AT THE PENINSULA SCHOOLS FOR 2001**

WHEREAS, in 1999, the Kenai Peninsula Borough began contracting with campers to serve as guardians of school grounds during summer vacation; and

WHEREAS, the program is an exchange of services, not money, whereby the summer guardians are offered a place to stay and a cell phone to report emergencies, plus electricity and water for their recreational vehicle in exchange for watching over school facilities; and

WHEREAS, prior to the inception of this program, vandalism at the schools had been a problem during the summer months with repair bills averaging \$20,000 for broken windows and other damage; and
