**A RESOLUTION COMMENDING CARA FOUTS FOR BEING NAMED THE ALASKA

WHEREAS, the Reflection Program provides an opportunity to submit entries based on an annual nationwide theme; and

WHEREAS, the Seward PTSA sponsored the local 2001-2002 program with the support of Seward Middle/High School staff, community members and local businesses; and

WHEREAS, Seward High School Senior, Cara Fouts, submitted original photography entries; and

WHEREAS, Cara advanced through the Alaska State PTA Region V competition to the state level, where she was chosen as the State Finalist for Photography, Senior Division, to represent the State of Alaska at the national level; and

WHEREAS, Cara received additional State recognition with an Honorable Mention for a second photography entry in the Senior Division; and

WHEREAS, Cara is a credit to her family, school and community and is to be commended for receiving these statewide awards;
