- WHEREAS, David Blanchard, along with his wife, Amalia; son, David; and crew member Chris Hermez, all from Louisiana, launched their private skiff after Ronald Eugene Halsey amazingly swam to shore in 40 knot winds to seek help; and
- WHEREAS, the Blanchards rescued Debbie Halsey who had tied herself to a buoy in the Inlet; and
- WHEREAS, these fishermen, without concern for themselves, risked their lives in saving others;

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:
