**A RESOLUTION COMMENDING ARI GOLDSTEIN FOR WINNING HER SECOND
CROSS COUNTRY CLASS 4A GIRLS STATE CHAMPIONSHIP**

WHEREAS, Soldotna High School had an excellent Cross Country team this season, under the direction of Head Coach Mark Devenney; and

WHEREAS, the State 4A Cross Country Running Championships were held at the Tsalteshi Trails in Soldotna; and

WHEREAS, last year as a junior Ari Goldstein won the 5-K race with a time of 18 minutes, 45 seconds, it was the first time a female runner from the Kenai Peninsula Borough had won the State 4A Championship; and

WHEREAS, at this years competition Ari Goldstein won the 5-K race with a time of 19 minutes, 1 second, nine seconds better than the second place winner, thus becoming a repeat State Champion; and

WHEREAS, her intent was to, “Go For It”, and with the inspiration from her team, go for it she did; and

WHEREAS, the performance of Ari Goldstein was superb and a credit to her parents, school and her community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:
