WHEREAS, he was the first physician in the Soldotna-Kenai area and worked tirelessly to get a hospital built in Soldotna; and

WHEREAS, Doc had many interests and after his retirement in 1983, he began learning about natural medicine; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Isaak was an avid hunter, fisherman and pilot, in addition to his expertise with rebuilding Supercubs in his shop; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Paul Isaak will be missed by his family, friends and co-workers, and all who knew him are saddened by his passing;
