**WHEREAS**, Bill served on several Boards including the Alaska-Korea Business Council, the Alaska District Export Council, and the Alaska Railroad Corporation;


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE ASSEMBLY OF THE KENAI PENINSULA BOROUGH:**


**SECTION 2.** That this resolution takes effect immediately upon its adoption.
